**AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SILSBEE, TEXAS APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR SAID CITY, AS PREPARED AND SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER OF SAID CITY, SUCH BUDGET COVERING THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2025, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2026.**
